VGS AWARDED PATHWAYS II CONTRACT

Recently, federal dollars were available for the State of Ohio to match in order to serve individuals with disabilities; however, the state was not in a position to provide funds to match the federal dollars. The Rehabilitation Services Commission received permission from the state and federal governments to develop agreements with local government entities in order to maximize the dollars available to provide vocational rehabilitation services to Ohioans with disabilities. This gave way to the Pathway II Program.
